IV INTERNATIONAL CHILDREN DRAWNG CONTEST EXPOCHESS THE TRANSVERSAL CULTURE OF CHESS

Instituted by **EXPOCHESS** organization* accordance with the following rules:

- 1. Children from 6 to 14 years old (two age ranges, from 6 to 9 and from 10 to 14 years old) and people over 14 years old can participate; divided into three categories. The theme will be **THE TRANSVERSAL CULTURE OF CHESS**, the techniques will be free (marker, pencil, tempera, wax, etc.) and the format will be A4 (210 x 297mm) or A3 (297 x 420mm).
- 2. Each author will participate with a single work (no more than one work will be admitted per author).
- 3. The representative of each country will select 8 drawings per age group. These 24 drawings in total per country are the ones that will opt for the prize.
- 4. The drawings that qualify for the prize of each category will be accompanied by a technical sheet with:

 Title, measures, technique, date of birth, sex and an explanatory text on the conceptual framework of the composition.
- 5. The drawings may be sent from September 5, 2019, after being convened in the presentation of the **EXPOCHESS GUATEMALA 2019**, and must be received before <u>November 07</u>, photographed or scanned (one by one) in digital format (jpg, tiff...), high resolution with a maximum of 8mb (do not send the original drawings on paper or other physical media) to the **website** provided by the organization or by <u>Wetransfer</u> to the following address: <u>info@expochess.org</u> specifying in the subject [participating country] + work + author, age and title. "INTERNATIONAL EXPOCHESS DRAWING COINTEST 2019" and the attached technical sheet or in the body of the message.
- 6. The 8 selected drawnings for each age range (6 to 9 years, 10 to 14 years and +14 years, 24 drawings in total), must be sent to info@expochess.org (by email or by Wetransfer) separated from the rest to avoid confusion.
- * All drawings submitted by the representatives will be admitted and, if one does not comply with the rules, his representative will be notified on November 18 by email or other media previously communicated.
- 7. Drawings that have won an award/prize in another contest will not be accepted.
- 8. The winning works will be exhibited at the **GRAN HOTEL LAKUA of Vitoria-Gasteiz** on November 23rd. That same day will be given the jury's decision and will be unappealable.
- 9. The best evaluated works by the jury, will opt for special prizes. The jury, if it deems it appropriate, may grant one or more honorable mentions (without economic endowment).
- 10. The authors of the drawings and their representatives, taking part in this contest accept all the rules set out in the present rules and authorize the organizers of EXPOCHESS CHILDREN OF THE WORLD to reproduce or exhibit their drawings (selected or not), and by the media they deem appropriate, in: Web pages, Blogs, media (press, TV...), social networks, books, magazines, posters...; the works that have obtained honorific mention will be recognized with a diploma.
